

Atacama Tours – Experience Overview

We are a specialized operator in motorcycle expeditions, also offering 4×4 experiences for those who wish to explore the desert with the same premium level of service, safety, and authenticity.

Our tours combine adventure, culture, and the breathtaking landscapes of the Atacama, featuring customizable itineraries designed around each traveler's preferences and pace.



General Information

- All-Inclusive: Senior guides trained in rescue, 4×4 support vehicles, Starlink satellite connection, park entry fees, gourmet open-air lunches, and carefully selected dinners.
- Yamaha Ténéré XT660Z Included: A legendary, durable motorcycle – easy to repair in the field. Its analog design and exceptional range make it the ideal machine for the extreme conditions and high altitudes of the Atacama Desert.
- Exceptional Climate: Over 330 clear days per year, allowing tours to operate year-round.
- Seasons:

High: December-March, July-August Mid: April-May, September-November Low: January-February, June (with light high-altitude rains)

• Languages: Tours can be conducted in English, Spanish, or Portuguese.

Tour Logistics

- Schedule and Tour Level: Departures usually take place between 8:00 and 9:00 a.m., with an estimated return between 5:00 and 6:00 p.m., depending on the itinerary, weather, and group pace.
- Daily routes cover between 120 and 250 km, with a medium to high difficulty level, adapted according to the group's experience and terrain conditions.
- The itinerary includes rest stops, scenic viewpoints to enjoy the landscape, and cultural visits to Atacama's traditional villages and iconic landmarks.
- Small Groups: Limited group sizes ensure safety, exclusivity, and personalized attention.
- Insurance and Requirements: Medical and travel insurance are mandatory, and a valid motorcycle driver's license is required to participate in motorcycle tours.
- Transfers: Airport transfers to and from the destination are optional and available at an additional cost.



Flights from Europe

- High Season (Dec-Mar / Sep-Nov):
 1,200€-1,600€ round trip ≈ \$1,300-\$1,730 USD round trip. Iberia, LATAM, Air France, KLM.
- Low Season (Apr-Aug): 850€-1,100€ round trip –
 \$920-\$1,190 USD round trip.
 Iberia, Air Europa, LATAM.
- **Tip:** Booking 2-3 months in advance can reduce airfare by 15-20%.
- Recommended Route: Barcelona → Santiago →
 Calama. From Calama, the journey to San Pedro
 de Atacama (where the tours operate) is by road
 and not included in the tour price.

Accommodation & Gastronomy

- Accommodation: Tours can be booked with or without lodging, although we highly recommend choosing our All-Inclusive Package, which includes accommodation at Casa Solcor Boutique B&B. This property has been personally selected by our team for its comfort, authenticity, and perfect alignment with the style and quality standards that define the Atacama Motorbike Tours experience.
- Rooms: The price always includes a double room, whether you're traveling solo or as a couple. If traveling with a third person, an extra bed can be added to the same room at an additional cost, or a separate room (double or single) can be arranged. All options are subject to availability and prior coordination.
- Gastronomy: Gourmet open-air lunches in iconic desert locations.

Selected dinners at our partner restaurants –
 Adobe, UNAI, La Casona, Desértica, among others – curated to reflect local flavor and Atacama's unique culinary identity.

Safety

- Expert Local Guides: Our local guides have over 25 years of experience in rescue operations, mountaineering, and regional tourism – along with extensive expertise in enduro motorcycling across the diverse terrains of the Atacama Desert.
- Constant Support: Each expedition includes 4×4 support vehicles equipped with advanced first-aid kits, immobilization stretchers, and Starlink satellite connection to ensure real-time communication at all times.
- Medical Assistance Nearby: A hospital is located just 5-10 minutes from San Pedro de Atacama, with private clinics and SAMU emergency services available in Calama (approximately 1.5 hours away).
- Rescue and Communication: A dedicated 4×4
 rescue unit and constant satellite connectivity
 provide a robust safety network throughout every
 stage of the journey.

Climate and Itinerary AdaptabilityW

 Each route is adjusted daily to ensure maximum safety and operational excellence. Due to the unique conditions of the Atacama Desert altitude, temperature variation, and possible highaltitude weather changes — all tours follow a dynamic planning approach, allowing routes and schedules to be adapted up to the last minute to guarantee the best possible experience and optimal riding conditions.





Group Sizes & Pricing

- Prices: from €2,990 (Explorer 4×4) to €5,940 (Enduro Signature with accommodation). For more details, please refer to the pricing table at the end of this document.
- A minimum number of participants is required; if not met, the booking will be rescheduled or refunded. Group Sizes: small and exclusive up to 5 riders on motorcycles, 5 riders with companions in 4×4, or 6 explorers in 4×4 format. (Adaptable with prior coordination.)
- Taxes: listed prices are net and do not include local Chilean taxes (19% VAT).

Full Moto: Enduro Signature & Duo Experience

Formats

- Enduro Signature: 5 or 6 days of pure adventure riding the Yamaha XT660Z, mastering diverse terrains across the Atacama.
- Duo Experience: 5 days of adventure combining a rider on a Yamaha XT660Z with a companion in a guided 4×4, sharing all the stops, highlights, and landscapes in total comfort.

Operations

- Peloton Style: A lead guide, followed by the group of riders, with a 4×4 support vehicle closing the expedition.
- Adaptive Pace: The daily rhythm is adjusted to the group's level, with the support vehicle always available for assistance or transfers.
- Six Terrain Types: Salt crust, volcanic sandstone, hard clay, coarse gravel, rocky pavement, and mixed sections of sand and asphalt.



Day-by-Day Itinerary (Moto & Duo)

- Day 1 Desert Plains & Intro Clinic: Acclimatization ride through salt flats and oases, including the first motorcycle handling clinic.
- Day 2 Craters & Heritage Villages: Ride to Monturaqui Crater, through desert valleys and traditional Atacameño villages (Peine / Toconao).
- Day 3 High-Altitude Lagoons & Volcanic Landscapes: Andean crossings above 4,000 m, Inca routes, and striking volcanic formations.
- Day 4 La Pacana Caldera & Crystal Lagoons: Expansive ignimbrite cliffs and pristine high-altitude lagoons.
- Day 5 Cordillera de la Sal & Enduro Challenge:
 Mixed terrains dunes, clay plains, and technical off-road sections designed for advanced riders.
- Day 6 Altiplanic Sunrise & El Tatio Geysers: Early departure to witness the sunrise over the thirdlargest geothermal field in the world, concluding the final riding day.

(For 5-day tours, the Enduro Challenge takes place on Day 4, and Day 5 focuses on the Altiplanic sunrise and El Tatio Geysers.)

By Vehicle: 4×4 Route

Format

- A 4-day journey entirely by premium 4×4 vehicle.
- Ideal for travelers seeking cultural immersion and breathtaking scenery without the need to ride.

Focus

- Cultural & Scenic: More time exploring ancestral villages, high-altitude lagoons, and geological landmarks.
- Comfort & Accessibility: A boutique experience in premium 4×4 vehicles, ensuring both adventure and refinement.

Day-by-Day Itinerary (4×4)

- Day 1 Desert Plains & Villages: Acclimatization, salt flats, and small Atacameño settlements.
- Day 2 Craters & Canyons: Monturaqui Crater, desert canyons, and cultural stops.
- Day 3 Lagoons & Volcanic Landscapes: Andean crossings, high-altitude lagoons, ancient glaciers, and panoramic volcano views.
- Day 4 La Pacana Caldera & Geysers: Ignimbrite cliffs, crystal lagoons, and a grand finale at the El Tatio Geysers.



Service Overview – Applicable to All Tours



Included Services

- Yamaha Ténéré XT660Z motorcycle, fully equipped and insured. In the Enduro Signature and Duo Experience formats, each rider is provided with their own motorcycle; the companion travels in the 4x4 support vehicle.
- In the Explorer 4x4 format, the experience takes place entirely aboard all-terrain vehicles, guided by local experts.
- Expert multilingual guides (Spanish, English, Portuguese) with over 25 years of experience in the region, trained in rescue and first aid.
- 4×4 support vehicles (one or two, depending on group size) for assistance, logistics, and gear transportation.
- On-route mechanical support, equipped with tools and basic spare parts for immediate maintenance.
- 24/7 Starlink satellite connectivity, ensuring constant communication even in the most remote areas
- Fuel included for the entire route.
- Guided routes and full assistance, carefully designed by our team after on-site exploration.
- Park entries, reserve access, and natural attraction fees included as per the itinerary.
- Geographical authenticity: traverse three mountain ranges, seven terrain types, and otherworldly landscapes.
- Accommodation & Meals:

 Casa Solcor Boutique B&B our preferred choice, featuring a pool, jacuzzi, gardens, and breakfast included.

- If you book accommodation with us:


